From 15 December 2019, the Léman Express will give each and every one of us new travel options throughout Greater Geneva and beyond. In total, 45 stations will be connected via 230 kilometres of tracks, making mobility easier for over a million inhabitants.

The reality of life in Greater Geneva calls for efficient and pragmatic cooperation between France and Switzerland. We are working together, day in day out, to make your life flow more smoothly.

The arrival of the Léman Express is an opportunity to revolutionise mobility in Greater Geneva. After years of work, we are convinced that the results will be well worth the funds invested to improve your mobility and your quality of life in our beautiful cross-border region.

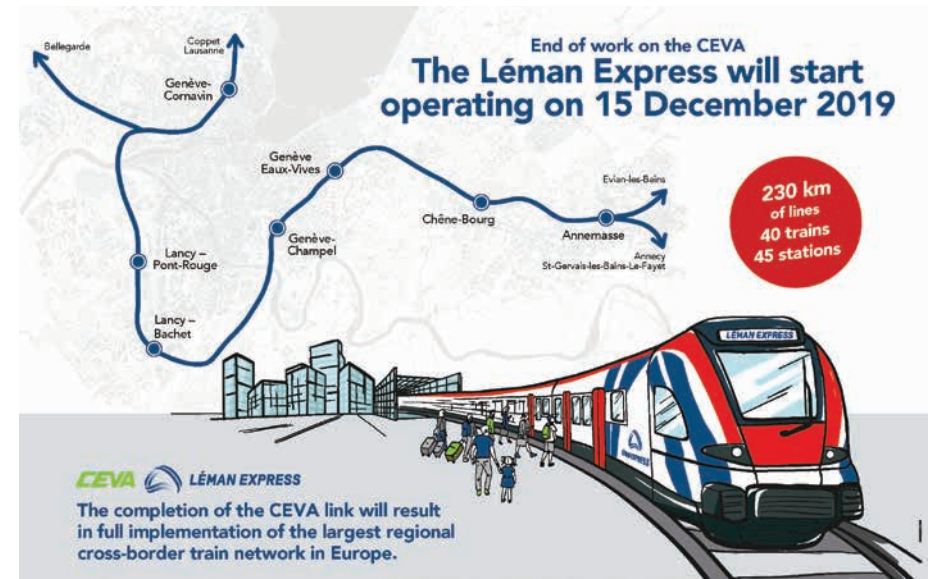

# THE LÉMAN EXPRESS IN PRACTICE



## Travelling from Thonon-les-Bains to Geneva–Eaux-Vives

- Up to **2** return journeys per hour at peak times.
- Journey time: **42** minutes, direct or change in Annemasse\*
- Single adult fare CHF **11.70** / € **10.30** \*\*

## Travelling from Annemasse to Coppet

- **1** direct train every **30** minutes all day long during the week
- Journey time: **29** minutes (by RegioExpress)
- Cost of a monthly adult travel pass CHF **211** / € **186.60** \*\*



## A round trip Geneva Cornavin – Saint-Gervais-les-Bains-Le Fayet on a weekend

- **1** train per hour or every 2 hours, depending on the time of day
- Journey time: **1 hr 44** outward journey and **1 hr 38** return journey direct or by changing in Annemasse or La Roche-sur-Foron\*
- Return adult fare CHF **43.10** / € **38.20** \*\*



## From Roche-sur-Foron to Lancy-Bachet via Annemasse

- **1** train every **30** minutes at peak times
- Journey time: **40** minutes, direct or change in Annemasse\*
- Cost of a monthly adult travel pass CHF **163.80** / € **144.90** \*\*

**New connections to Haute-Savoie**  
→ Lines L1, L2, L3 and L4 will link Coppet to Evian-les-Bains, Annecy, Saint-Gervais-les-Bains-Le Fayet and Annemasse.

**Evian-les-Bains**  
→ Up to 2 trains per hour at peak times.  
→ 1 train per hour during the rest of the day, in both directions. Direct or change in Annemasse\*.

**Geneva - Annemasse**  
6 trains per hour each way:  
→ 4 Léman Express trains (stopping at all stations) every 15 minutes from Monday to Sunday.  
→ 2 RegioExpress trains (stopping at Lancy-Pont-Rouge and Geneva-Eaux-Vives) every 30 minutes, from Monday to Friday and one train per hour at the weekend.  
→ The service will be available from 5:00 to 00:30 during the week and 24 hours a day at the weekend.

**Lines L5 and L6**  
→ Enhanced transport capacity thanks to the longer platforms.

**TER lines**  
→ 3 extra round trips per day during the week between Annemasse, Saint-Julien-en-Genevois and Bellegarde (Valserhône).

**Annecy and Saint-Gervais-les-Bains-Le Fayet**  
→ 2 trains per hour at peak times  
→ 1 train per hour during the rest of the day, in both directions. Direct or change in Annemasse or La Roche-sur-Foron.\*

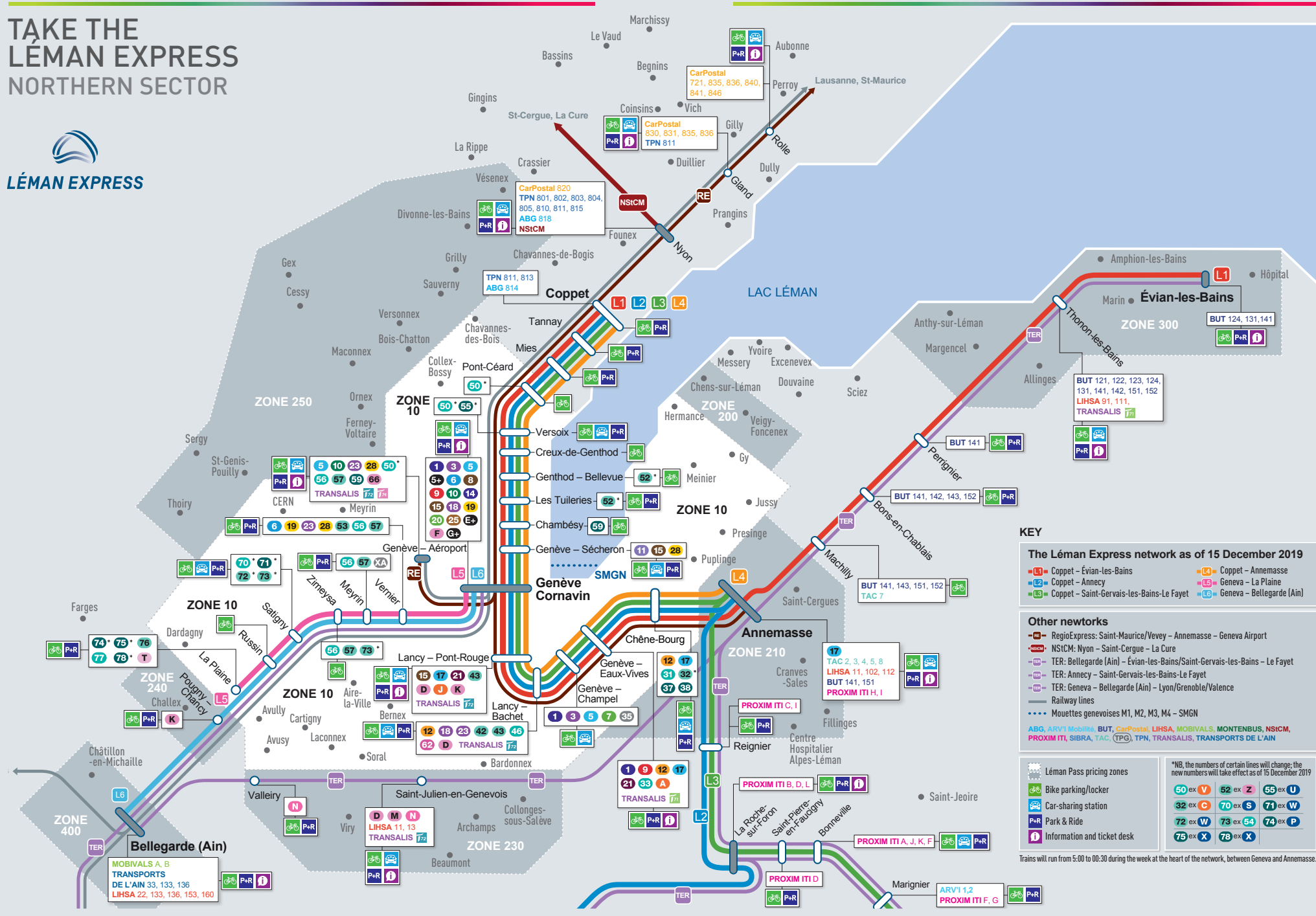

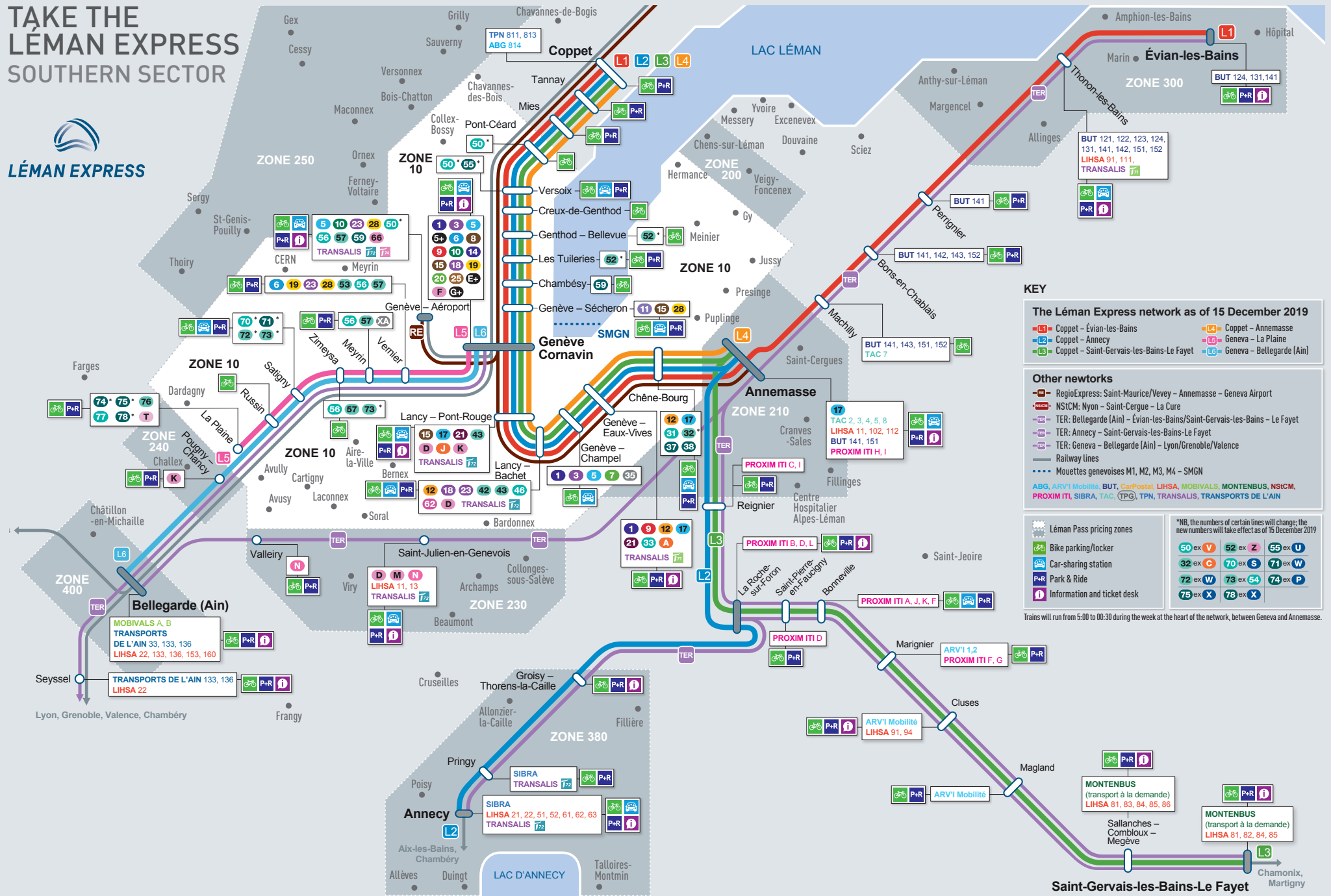

New cross-border fares from 15 December 2019

### You cross the French-Swiss border ?

The Léman Pass is your new ticket that will allow you to travel on all public transport: trains, buses and coaches within the Léman Express sector, trams or lake shuttles within the participating zones (see map of zones on pages 8 to 11).

Léman Pass is on sale via the usual distribution channels (agencies, retailers, webshop, mobile app, travel centres). Monthly/annual passes will be loaded onto SwissPass cards in Switzerland and Oûra cards in France.

### You only travel within the canton of Geneva ?

Your zone 10 unireso ticket or travel pass will remain unchanged for your journeys by train (new Léman Express lines included at no extra cost), tram, bus and lake shuttle.

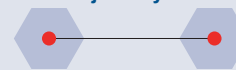
### You only travel within France or Switzerland ?

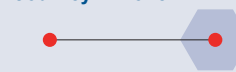
#### Zone — journey — zone

# GREATER GENEVA, ESSENTIAL CROSS-BORDER COOPERATION

## Greater Geneva covers

- two countries: Switzerland and France
- two Swiss cantons: Geneva and Vaud
- two French departments: Ain and Haute-Savoie
- one region: Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes

With more than a million inhabitants and over 500,000 jobs, Greater Geneva is one of the most dynamic regions in Europe.

Cross-border cooperation in this catchment area has been developing since 1973, when the Franco-Geneva Regional Committee conurbations policy in 2003, the first meeting of the "Conurbation steering committee" was held, bringing together partners from the France-Vaud-Geneva region. In 2013, they confirmed their willingness to work together in a legal entity appointed from Greater Geneva.
